POZNAŃ

Poznań, with a population of 600,000 is conveniently located and accessible by rail or air from any corner of Europe. Poznań is also situated on the Paris-Moscow route, leading across half the continent. Poznań owes its economic success not only to its location, but also its hard-working citizens, who are well known for their responsible attitude to work and organization. After Warsaw, it is the most vigorously developing city in Poland

It is no problem for visitors to have a delicious meal, use an Internet café, get cash from an ATM or communicate in a foreign language with local inhabitants.

Poznań is a large academic centre, with more than 100,000 students attending over a dozen universities.





Tourists flock to the city centre where the Old Town Square contains a wealth of historical monuments and museums. The Renaissance town hall houses the Historical Museum of Poznań and the Museum of Musical Instruments is located nearby. Not far from the square stands the parish church, one of Poland's most impressive Baroque buildings with rich interior decorations

The former royal castle located on the hilltop houses the Museum of Decorative Arts, and on the hill's slope the Baroque Franciscan church was erected. In 966, the Ostrów Tumski Island witnessed the baptism of the first hide the remains of the old churches

(10th-11th cc.) and of the tombs belonging to the first Piasts. In addition to the famous international trade fairs, Poznań is known for its rich cultural life secured by the opera house, Polish Dance Theatre, other theatres and cabarets, men's and boys' choirs, annual Wieniawski international violin competition and the Malta international theatre festival. The city has a number of rest and recreation grounds on the lakes (Malta, Strzeszynek, Kiekrz), regatta fairway and the Malta ski centre open throughout the year.



HOW TO GET TO POZNAŃ

ŁAWICA – POZNAŃ AIRPORT

In Poznań we have an international airport with many good connections. Some of them are especially active during summertime from May to October. The airport is located close to the Poznań Internation! Fair (around 10 mins by car). Shuttle for the Congress participants will be provided. There will be an information desk for the Congress participants at the airport. Currency exchange is located near the main entrance and on the entresol of the Passenger Terminal. There is also bank, and two cash machines.

RAILWAY STATION

The railway station is located in the city centre, opposite to the Congress venue.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

In Poznań public transport means are buses and trams. The costs of tickets depend on the time of traveling and they are as follows:

standard ticket for 10 mins: 1,20 PLN standard ticket for 30 mins: 2,40 PLN standard ticket for 60 mins: 3,60 PLN standard ticket for 90 mins: 4,80 PLN daily ticket (valid 24 hrs): 10,20 PLN weekly ticket (valid 7 days): 24 PLN

TAVIÉC

Taxi-cabs await passengers at designated taxi stands, e.g. near railway stations, airports, hotels. They are marked with TAXI sign and a telephone number of the corporation for which they work. Another way of getting a taxi is to order one by phone. Taxi fares are higher at night (10 pm to 6 am) and outside city boundaries, but you still pay by the kilometer. Fare for transport between cities should be negotiated with the driver. To avoid overestimation of the rates it is recommended to use the corporate taxies.

GENERAL INFORMATION

CURRENCY

The Poland's currency is zloty (PLN). 1 zloty equals 100 groszy (gro-sh-ee). In circulation there are 1-, 2-, 5-, 10-, 20-, and 50 groszy coins as well as 1-, 2-, and 5 zloty coins. The bank notes have 10, 20, 50, 100, and 200 zloty nominal.

CREDIT CARDS

All major credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, American Express) are accepted in hotels, restaurants and shops.

BANKS

Bank business hours are from Monday to Friday, 8 a.m. – 6 p.m., Saturday some banks are open from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. Banks are closed on Sunday and Public Holidays. There are many cash machines available in every city.

PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS

Participants from EU require a valid ID or passport. Participants outside EU will require a valid passport. A visa is required for citizens of some countries. Please consult the Polish Embassy or Consulate in your country.

CAR RENTALS

Tourists coming to Poland may rent automobiles with or without drivers from specialized international rent-a-car companies, or from Polish private rental offices. Car rental services are also found at border crossings, airports and hotel receptions.

POST

Post offices are open Monday to Saturday from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.. In cities there are post offices on duty, which work 24 hours daily. At the post office you can use a phone-card telephone and buy a phone-card.

TRAVELLING BY TRAIN

Passengers are serviced by PKP – the Polish State Railways. Three types of trains are available: intercity, eurocity and expresses; fast and slow trains. Passengers can travel in two classes: first and second. To travel in eurocity, intercity and express trains, passengers must purchase so called miejscówka, which entitles them to take a given seat on a train. Trains operating on long distances frequently have additional buffet cars and sleeping cars. Foreigners cannot take advantage of discounts for students and school children.

Tickets for distances over 100 km are valid for two days, however the journey must start on the first day of the ticket validity. More information: www.pkp.pl. Page available also in English.

WEATHER

The average temperature in Poland in June is 21° C. During this season the weather is mostly sunny.

VOLTAGE

Electricity in Poland is 220-volt current. Plugs are European standard with two round pins.

RESIDENCIES OF WIELKOPOLSKA

ROGALIN In the wings of the Palace we can see the old furniture, handicrafts and paintings, as well as a reconstruction of the London study of Edward Bernard Raczyński, the last émigré president of the Polish Republic.

Nowadays, the library and the castle, in which painting and handicraft, numismatic, ethnographic and archeological exhibits are now on show, constitute an unique place in Poland. The park around the castle, with its 3000 species of trees and shrubs from Europe, Asia and America, stands out as Poland's most interesting arboretum.

KÓRNIK CASTLE This is a romantic residence styled as a Gothic castle. It is surrounded by a moat and a park with exotic trees and embodied in the legend of the White Lady who wanders about the halls of the castle at night.

GARDENS

FULL DAY TOUR WIELKOPOLSKA IN A NUTSHELL

Uzarzewo. Museum of Natural Environment and Hunting. In the manor house and the stable from XIX century there is presented the development of hunting and weapon, hunting trophies, environments of warrantable game and a collection of birds.

Czerniejewo. Well-preserved Classicistic mansion connected with a landscape park from XVIII century. The majority of palace interiors house an exposition, some of them are used as hotel rooms. **Koszuty.** The manor house from XVIII century houses a constant exposition presenting furnishings of former manor houses from the turn of XIX and XX century. The functions of the interiors were kept according to the former division. In particular rooms there are pieces of furniture, paintings and abject of daily usage. The manor house is surrounded by a landscape park.

Kórnik. This is a romantic residence styled as a Gothic castle. It is surrounded by a moat and a park with exotic trees and embodied in the legend of the White Lady who wanders about the halls of the castle at night.
