

SCIENTIFIC INFORMATION AND CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

ABSTRACTS

Abstracts must be submitted by e-mail, following the format instructions given in the subsequent sections. Please do not submit the same abstract more than once. The abstract must be written in English.

The abstract form is not included in the printed announcement but is available online at the congress website www.pharm.unifi.it/isc2004.html.

All abstracts are subject to acceptance by the Scientific Advisory Board, and will be presented as posters. The best submitted abstracts might be selected for oral presentation in plenary sessions or in the poster discussion session.

Fit the abstract into the box (23 cm high and 16 cm wide) and print in characters no smaller than 12 characters per inch (cpi). Single-space all typing. The title should be brief and descriptive and should be typed in all capital letters and in bold face. Authors' names should include first initials and last names. Underline the name of the presenting author. List the institution(s) of the author(s). Give only name of the institution, city and country, no address or ZIP code. Leave a single space line between the affiliations and the text of the abstract. If references are cited in the abstract, they should be in the following format (Smith et al., BMJ 1999; 55:100-2) within the text.

Simple tables may be included if they fit within the space allowed. However, use the tab key, not the space bar, to separate data points in tables. If you use a table editor feature of your word-processing software, ensure that each data point is contained within a unique cell, i.e. do not use carriage returns within cells. Figures are not permitted.

Send the abstract, saved as a WORD or Rich Text Format document, by email as an attachment file (not pasted onto your message) to the e-mail address isc2004@pharm.unifi.it after filling in the first page containing contact details for the corresponding author, the abstract title, full list of authors, affiliations and the name of the presenting author.
