Call for abstracts

The participants wishing to present a paper are requested to submit the abstract (on the attached form) to the secretariat not later than **May 31, 2003,** together with their Registration Form and fees.

Participants will be informed whether their abstract has been selected for oral communication or poster presentation by **July 15, 2003.** All accepted abstracts will be printed in the Book of Abstracts.

Publication of Symposium paper

The full text of accepted lectures (max 8 pages, figures, references and tables included), oral presentations (max 8 pages) and posters (max 4 pages) will be published in Symposium Proceedings. The manuscripts should be double spaced, on one side only of the sheet: the references, footnotes and figure legends should be single-spaced. The typing form of the page must be exactly 16 cm by 24 cm. The entire form of the page must be filled, leaving no wasted space. The title page should include the title, the name of the authors and the address. The running title and the key words should be clearly indicated. Text should be composed of the following part: Summary (not exceeding 100 words), Introduction, Material and Methods, Results, Discussion and Acknowledgments. References should be listed at the end of the paper and numbered consecutively as they occur in the text. The references should include, in the order: the author's last name, his initials, the title of the paper, the journal name in abbreviated form, the volume number, pages and year. The book references should include the authors name, the editors, the publishers, the city and the year of publication.

Figures: black and white photographic prints done professionally, and legible even after figure's size reduction by the publisher. A label indicating the figure's number, the name of the authors and the top of the figure should be pasted gently on the back. The full text should be mailed together with the abstract. **A diskette must accompany the hard copy.**
