How to get to the Meeting venue:

Arrival by train

Convitto della Calza is located near to the city centre (Porta Romana area) and is easy to reach from the main railway station "S. Maria Novella" by ATAF public bus service (about 15 minutes with n. 36, 37, 11; stop at Piazza della Calza – for bus timetable see www.ATAF.net).

Alternatively only 10 minutes by taxi.

Arrival by plane

The Meeting venue can be reached from "A. Vespucci" airport of Florence by taxi (about 20 min) or by shuttle service Volainbus (for bus timetable see www.ATAF.net) to "S. Maria Novella" railway station (about 30 min) and from there by ATAF public bus service (see above).

Scientific Information and Call For Abstracts

ABSTRACTS

Abstracts must be submitted by e-mail, following the format instructions given in the subsequent sections.

Please do not make multiple submissions of the same abstract.

Abstract must be written in English.

The abstract form is not included in the printed announcement but is available online at the Meeting website www.pharm.unifi.it/pamm2003.html.

All abstracts are subject to acceptance by the Scientific Advisory Board, and will be oral or poster presentations.

Fit the abstract into the box (23 cm high and 16 cm wide) and print in characters no smaller than 12 characters per inch (cpi). Single-space all typing. The title should be brief and descriptive and should be typed in all capital letters. Authors' name should include first initials and last names. Underline the name of the presenting author. List the institution(s) of the author(s). Give only name of the institution, city and country, no address or ZIP code.

Leave a single line space between the authors/affiliations and the text of the abstract. If references must be cited in the abstract, they should be in the following format (Smith []. et al., BMJ 1999; 55:100-2) within the text.

Simple tables may be included if they fit within the space allowed. However, use the tab key, not the space bar, to separate data points in tables. If you use a table editor feature of your word-processing software, ensure that each data point is contained within an unique cell, i.e. do not use carriage returns within cells.

Figures are not permitted.

Send the abstract, saved as a WORD or Rich Text Format document, by e-mail as an attachment file (not as an enclosure) to the Scientific Secretariat (e-mail address pamm2003@unifi.it) after filling in the first page with the contact details for the corresponding author along with the abstract title, full list of authors and affiliations and the name of the presenting author.

Registration is necessary for presentation of the abstract.

Deadline for submission of abstracts is: December 6, 2002

BURSARIES
